

Cimarron Park Family Aquatic Center

MDE designed the MEP systems for a \$3.6 million, 11,000 square-foot waterpark with amenities. The modern leisure pool layout provides a separate toddler pool and a main body of water with a zero entry area, child play/slide structure, geysers, 18-ft platform slide with two flumes, and five 25-yd lap lanes with one end at a 6-ft depth for water aerobics. The 2,800 square-foot of support buildings are contained in three separate structures which house toilets, changing and locker facilities, reception, guard, first aid, concessions, storage, mechanical room and storage. This project was completed in the spring of 2008.
